

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p><b>Explorers bring trouble to a new continent.</b> In 1492, Columbus helped cockroaches, worms and rats first invade the Americas.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>GO BACK 5 SPACES</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p>American plants change the way Europe eats (vanilla, corn, tobacco, potatoes, chocolate, pumpkins). <b>Worldwide, trade changes the way everyone eats.</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>ROLL THE DICE, IF EVEN #, GO BACK 10 SPACES, IF ODD # GO FORWARD 10 SPACES</b></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p><b>ARE YOU AN INVASIVE?</b> People invaded America killing wolves and cougars. Now deer are everywhere. Are you an invasive?</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>SKIP A TURN WHILE YOU THINK ABOUT IT.</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p><b>CONFUSED.</b> You brought a Norway maple tree from New York to Massachussetts for a friend. It's against the law to bring these maples into Massachussetts. Each state has different laws.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>SKIP A TURN AS YOU TAKE THE TREE BACK .</b></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p>Does the planet Mars have life or did we accidentally bring it there? Was the equipment cleaned well enough before it left the earth?</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>SKIP A TURN</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p>Did you just move a creature to a new home? Was the boat you used on one lake clean enough to be used on another lake or river. YES, you dried it and cleaned it!</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>MOVE FORWARD 3 SPACES.</b></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p>Moving firewood spreads insects and diseases. In New York you can't move firewood more than 50 miles.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>GO BACK 5 SPACES.</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p>Your captain discharges <b>your ship's ballast water at the dock – and not at sea!</b> You release dozens of new creatures into the bay. You get a fine and are told to leave the port.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>GO BACK TO A SPACE TOUCHING THE NEAREST OCEAN.</b></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p><b>TEMPERATURES RISE!</b> Kudzu, a vine that has smothered parts of the south moves north. SKIP A TURN, while you check to see if its arrived in your neighborhood.</p> <p><b>Is it there?</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>ROLL THE DICE EVEN # GO BACK 6 SPACES, ODD # GO FORWARD 3 SPACES .</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p><b>Before 1850</b> most introductions were deliberate (90%), <b>after 1950</b> most introductions were accidents.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>ROLL DICE: EVEN # GO BACK, ODD # GO FORWARD.</b></p>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p>It's getting warmer. New bugs, plants and diseases are moving north.</p> <p><b>SKIP A TURN WHILE YOU WAIT FOR THE NEXT ARRIVAL.</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p>Some plants and animals have been around for a long time and are everywhere. 1/3 of all the plants in New York are from somewhere else. Some are good, some bad (invasives).</p> <p><b>ROLL THE DICE, GO FORWARD IF YOU GET AN EVEN NUMBER, BACK IF YOU GET AN ODD NUMBER.</b></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p>It's too late for those brought in (like starlings), or who have sneaked in (like rats and cockroaches). Once an invasive sneaks in, it's here for good! Learn to live with it.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>SKIP A TURN.</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p>Invasives can be stopped, but only if they don't get a foothold.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>ROLL THE DICE, EVEN # GO FORWARD 3 SPACES, ODD # GO BACK 3 SPACES.</b></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p>It's not a one way street. Invasives travel from the United States to other countries too!</p> <p><b>GO 4 SPACES IN A DIRECTION AWAY FROM THE UNITED STATES.</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p>Trade slows down (<b>A bad thing</b>). The number of invasive plants and animals moving around the world goes down (<b>A good thing</b>).</p> <p><b>SKIP A TURN OR TAKE A CHANCE – ROLL EVEN GO FORWARD, ODD GO BACKWARD</b></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p>Invasives plants and animals travel to new places in times of war. Invasives in an invasion. The army has inspectors to reduce the accidental movement of plants and animals.</p> <p><b>GO FORWARD 3 SPACES</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p><b>Invasives on the move.</b> Top 2 ways are <u>trade</u> (wood packaging materials and ballast water) and <u>landscape plants</u>.</p> <p><b>GO BACK 3 SPACES</b></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p><b>KILLER OUTDOOR CATS</b> spread from North Africa to Europe to America and beyond. An outdoor cat can kills more than 100 birds, small mammals, insects, amphibians and reptiles each year.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>GO BACK 10 SPACES</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CAUSE</b></p> <p>Invasives cause extinctions, Push out natives not as strong as they are. Reduce the number of living creatures - plant, animal, fungal and bacterial – on earth.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>SKIP A TURN</b></p>

**CAUSE**

European and southern earthworms are moving into areas in North America where there were no earthworms before. They're changing the soil and killing off native plants. They are great for gardens though.

**ROLL THE DICE, EVEN # FORWARD 2 SPACES, ODD # BACK 2 SPACES.**

**CAUSE**

Not enough inspectors. In December, bugs sneak in on blueberries you bought that were flown in from the other half of the world (where its summer). A few months later... blueberries are hard to find at home.


**GO BACK 3 SPACES**

**CAUSE**

Not enough inspectors. More inspectors needed at airports, border crossings and ports to monitor travelers and trade. Leads to more jobs, but also higher prices for everything.

**GO FORWARD 5 SPACES(THEN BACK 3)**

**CAUSE**



What state has the largest number of invasive forest pest species in the United States? Why? **GO BACK 5 SPACES**

**CAUSE**

Plants, wood and materials are moved around the world. We're moving bugs and diseases. Where do we trade with? The Federal Government should get serious about monitoring trade. Otherwise, we really loose. **GO BACK TO A QUARANTINE AND MISS A TURN.**

**CAUSE**

You get on a plane with mud on your shoes. All sorts of seeds, creatures, bacteria and fungi can be stuck on the bottom.

**SKIP A TURN**, while your shoes are cleaned before you enter the country your visiting.
